In the Plate section they beat Sandford Park 24-4. In the second round they beat Kilkenny College 12 pts. to 6 pts. The next round was the semi-final, where they defeated Marian College who had previously beaten them in the 1st round. This time they won 12 pts. to 0 pts.
